Dear Mr Brown

Thank you for your fax of 26 November 2004 and emails of 26 November, 1 and 21 December 2004 regarding the provision of recycled water to the St Marys ADI development. I apologise for the delay in responding.

I am advised that Sydney Water is involved in detailed commercial negotiations with the developer of the St Marys ADI site. These negotiations include the issue of recycled water supply for stage 1 of the development using treated effluent from St Marys Sewage Treatment Plant. The discussions are considering the funding, timing and location of recycled water infrastructure.

To Sydney Water's knowledge, the installation of a small private grey water recycling plant has not been contemplated.

Regarding the issuing of a Section 73 Certificate to the developer, I am advised that Sydney Water has issued a pending Section 73 Notice of Requirements. Sydney Water has not yet issued a final Section 73 Certificate, and no water or sewerage pipes will be laid until Sydney Water has endorsed the developer's detailed plans.

I trust that this information will be of assistance.
