Re: Invite to address Save the ADI Site rally at NSW Parliament

Dear Premier,

We invite you to address the Save the ADI Site rally to be held outside of Parliament House at 12.30pm, Thursday the 13th of May 2004.

A statement by you that the NSW Government has decided to stop the development of the ADI Site by repealing Sydney Regional Environmental Plan 30 –St Marys and replacing it with another planning instrument or State Environmental Planning Policy protecting the land for conservation purposes would be warmly received by those in attendance at the rally and by the majority of NSW residents.

You can then expand on your vision for the ADI Site of it becoming the “worlds best Regional Park” as quoted by you in the May 4 2004 edition of the Penrith Star. This is obviously a reality now that treasurer Egan has confirmed, on May 11 2004, that no compensation is payable by the State to Lend Lease if the development does not proceed. Also, as development consent has yet to be given to Lend Lease your government can legally exercise its right under the NSW Planning and Assessment Act 1979 to repeal SREP 30- St Marys.

Premier we look forward to your attendance and imminent announcement at Thursdays rally of the creation of one of the world’s greatest urban parklands at St Marys.
