The purpose of this letter is to determine the position of all current Councillors in respect to the development of the ADI Site St Marys. The ADI Residents Action Group will be campaigning at the forthcoming 2004 council elections that the ADI Site be retained in full public ownership as a National Park.

If you intend to stand for re-election to Council we ask that you answer the following questions. If we received no reply within 2 weeks from the date of this letter then we will take this as meaning you offer no support for the protection of the ADI Site. If not seeking re-election please reply ASAP clearly stating this.

- 1. Do you support the protection of the entire ADI Site as a National Park? If yes/no why?*
- 2. If elected to Council will you oppose any development of the ADI Site? If yes/no why?*
- 3. If elected to Council will you oppose the filling of any areas of the ADI Sites floodplain; furthermore, do you believe this loss of floodplain will have an impact on localised flooding? If yes/no why?*
- 4. If elected to council will you publicly oppose the State Government if they take away the planning authority of Council? If yes/no why?*
- 5. Do you support the developers and the State Governments decision to displace the majority of Kangaroos and Emus from the ADI Site? If yes/no why?*
- 6. Do believe that the ADI development is a model urban development and meets the principles of Ecologically Sustainable Development? If yes/no why?*
- 7. Do you believe that the impacts the proposed urban development will have on the remaining conservation values of the ADI Site will be off set by the proposed Regional Park? If yes/no why?*
- 8. Do you support the findings of previous studies of the ADI Site; furthermore are you content to base your decisions upon these prior studies when determining the development of the ADI Site? If yes/no why?*
- 9. Do you support the sale of public land to property developers or non-public institutions? If yes/no why?*
