The ADI Residents Action Group are still awaiting word from yourself as to whether you or a representative of the state government will be attending the public meeting at the St Marys Memorial Hall, Thursday the 13th February.

The meeting as you are aware is important in terms of facilitating dialogue between residents, developers and government. Lately several letters to the local papers from your constituents have expressed doubt about the proposed development of the ADI Site by Delfin/Lend Lease. It appeared that these residents had approached Delfin/Lend Lease who refused to answer some of their questions. These residents concerns only represent the tip of the iceberg in terms of a lack of creditable information about the ADI Site development. Therefore, it is crucial in the lead up to the release of the first precinct that the community be fully informed about the formal planning process and how they can contribute to it.

It is therefore disappointing that you have so far failed to acknowledge the invitation to address this public forum. The message you are sending is that you lack concern for how this development may impact on the lives of your local residents.

Although this is not a political forum it is worth noting that Liberal candidate for Londonderry, Kevin Connolly, has indicated he will be in attendance at the meeting.
