I recently contacted your Office by phone to invite you to address a public meeting organised by the ADI Residents Action Group to discuss proposals by the NSW Government to exclude from the Regional Park large areas of the 828 ha of National Estate listed land that Penrith Council has consistently stated would be protected and included in a 900 ha Regional Park.

The NSW Governments proposal means that large parts of the National Estate, assumed to be retained in public ownership, will be owned by Lend Lease, a property developer.

I received a phone call several days ago from Planner, Tony Crichton, seeking clarification about the meeting. I have yet to receive confirmation that Penrith Council will address the public meeting to outline its response to the NSW Governments proposals.

I understand that you are not available at this time so either the Deputy Mayor, a senior Councillor or Planner could outline Councils response and position on protection of the RNE lands.
